

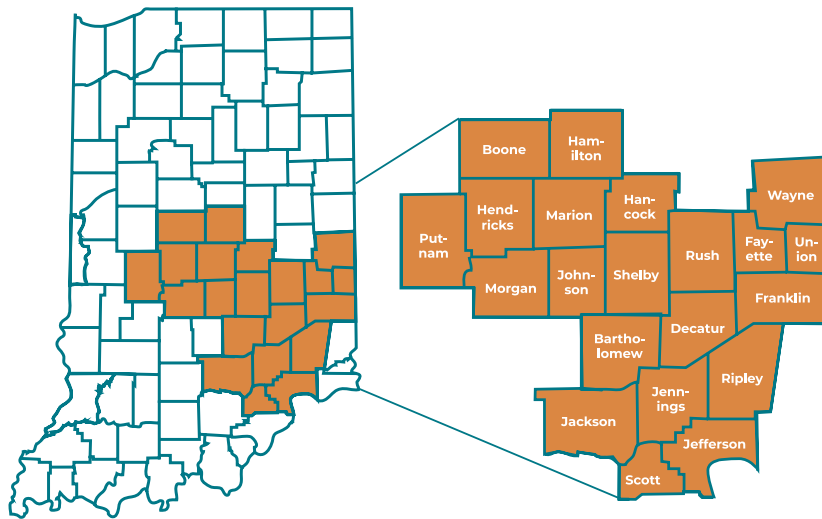

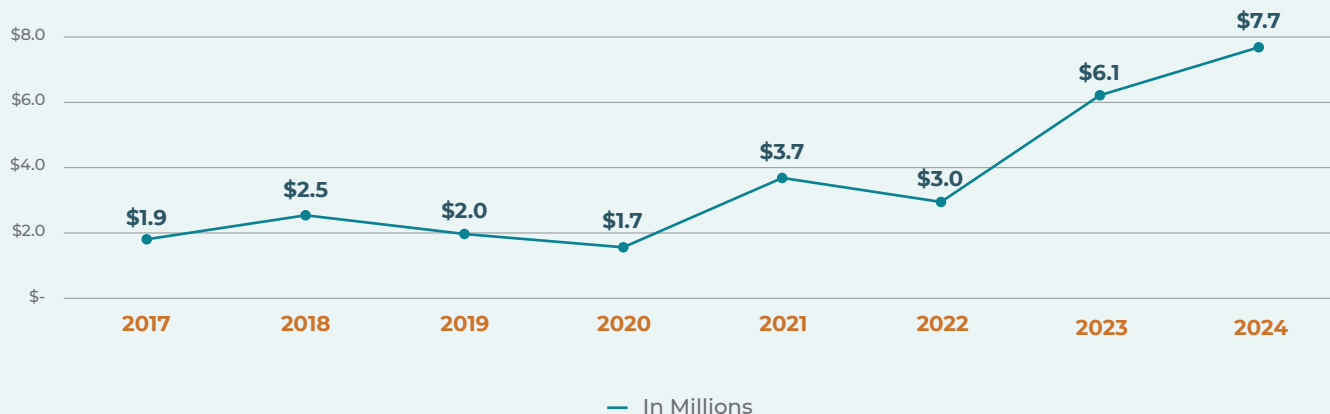

Gleaners Food Acquisition Budget

Prior to the pandemic, Gleaners purchased approximately one-third of the food distributed. With the increasing and sustained need and the decline in government support, Gleaners is projected to spend a record **\$7.7 million** just to purchase food in 2024.

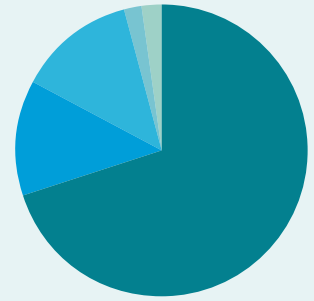

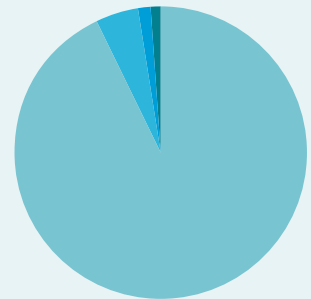
