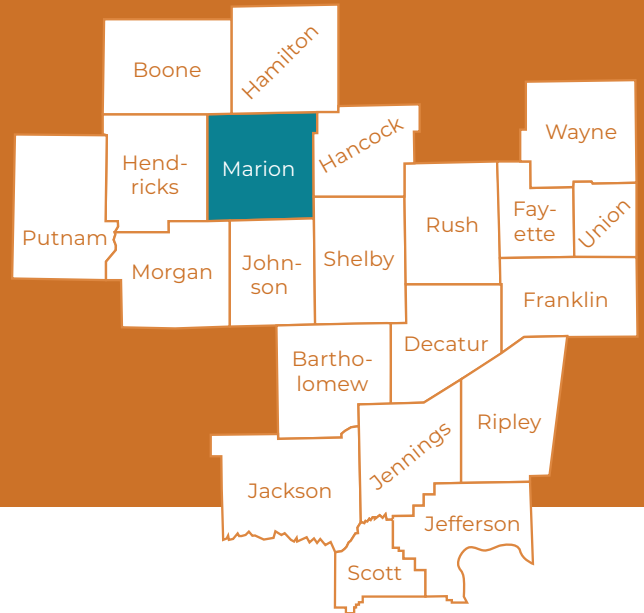




# MARION COUNTY 2024 OVERVIEW

SNAP assistance, including pre-screening and application assistance, is available through our Outreach team.



### Mobile Pantries

Mobile pantries help meet increased need through no-contact, drive-thru distributions.



### Youth Programs

**31** school-based pantries serve students and their families and are open to the public.



### Nutrition Hub

**66%** of food ranked green or yellow based on HER guidelines.

### Network Partners

**110** network partners serve neighbors throughout the county.



### CARE Mobile Pantries

**600,000** meals provided in 2023.
