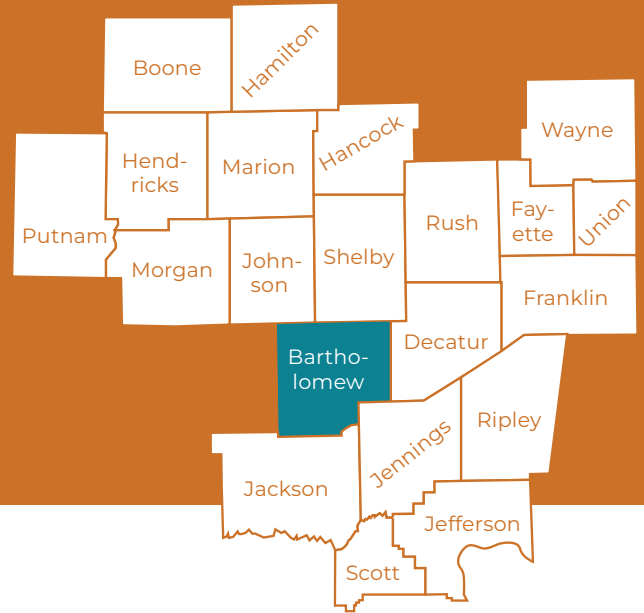

 **55%** are likely ineligible for SNAP benefits due to income limits.

 That's **15%** of children living in Bartholomew County.

 **24%** are likely ineligible for federal child nutrition programs.
