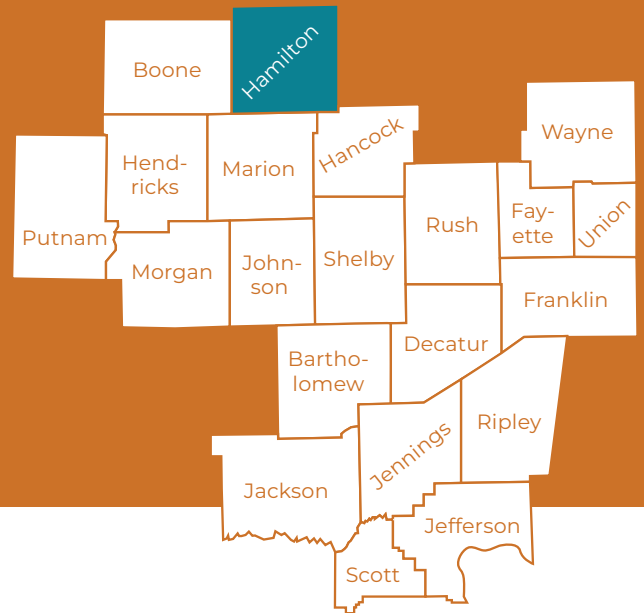




# HAMILTON COUNTY 2025 OVERVIEW
