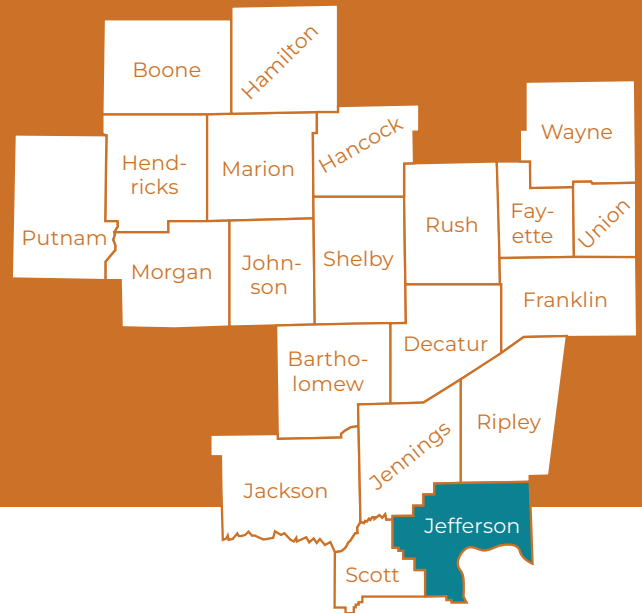



# JEFFERSON COUNTY 2025 OVERVIEW
