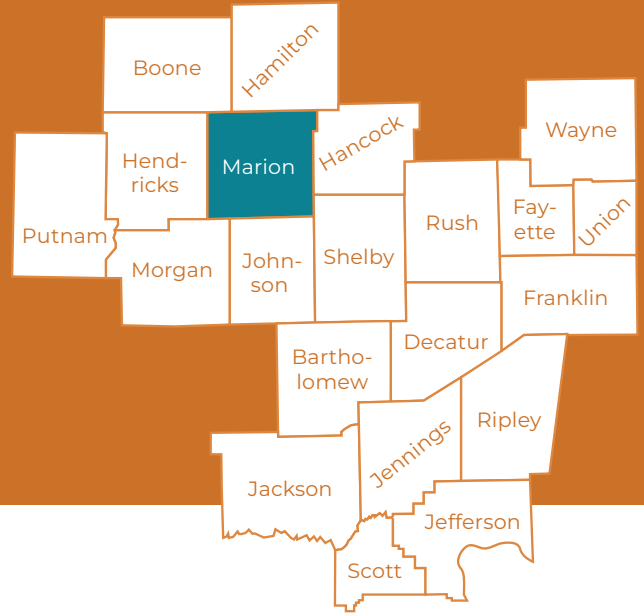



# MARION COUNTY 2025 OVERVIEW

**37** school-based pantries serve students and their families and are open to the public.



**Nutrition Programs**

**69%** of food distributed was rated as nutritious



**Network Partners**

**140** network partners serve neighbors throughout the county.

**598,779** meals provided in 2024.
