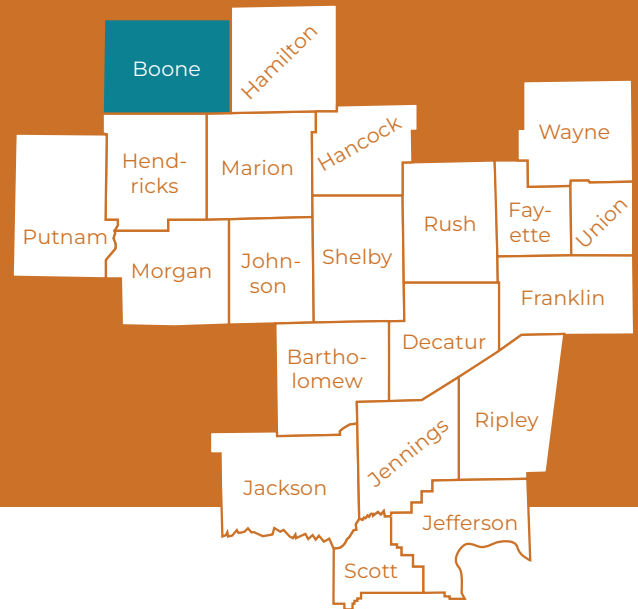




BOONE COUNTY 2026 OVERVIEW
