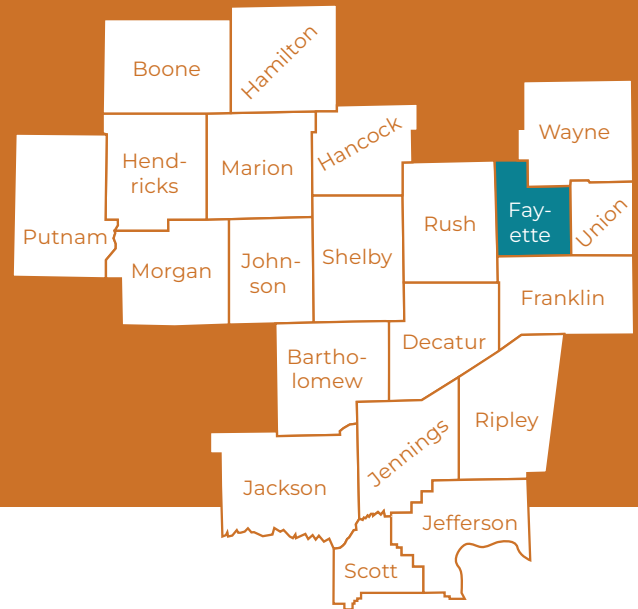




FAYETTE COUNTY 2026 OVERVIEW
