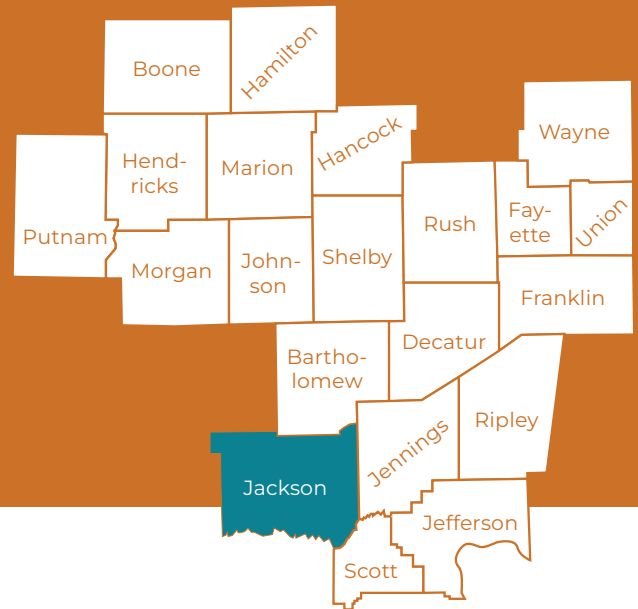




JACKSON COUNTY 2026 OVERVIEW
