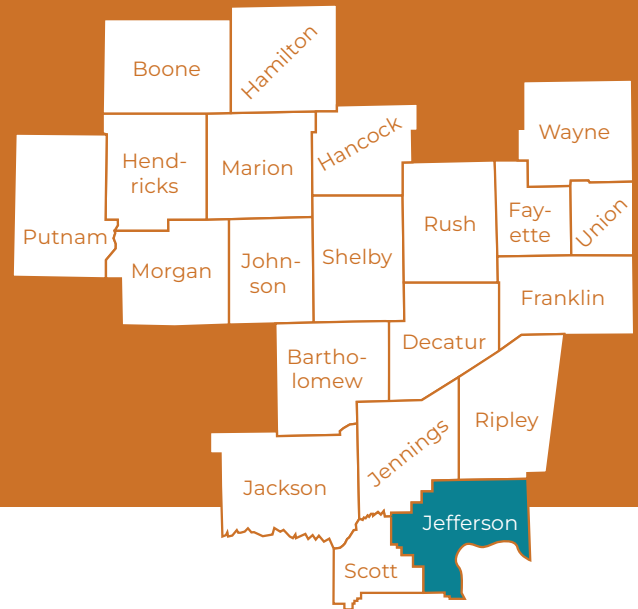


JEFFERSON COUNTY 2026 OVERVIEW
