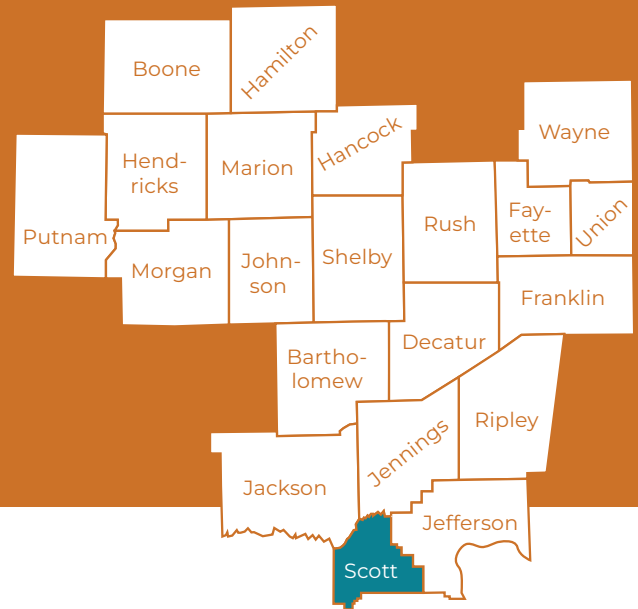


SCOTT COUNTY 2026 OVERVIEW

Employed families who work but earn too much to qualify for federal assistance, yet not enough to cover basic necessities like housing, food, childcare, and healthcare
