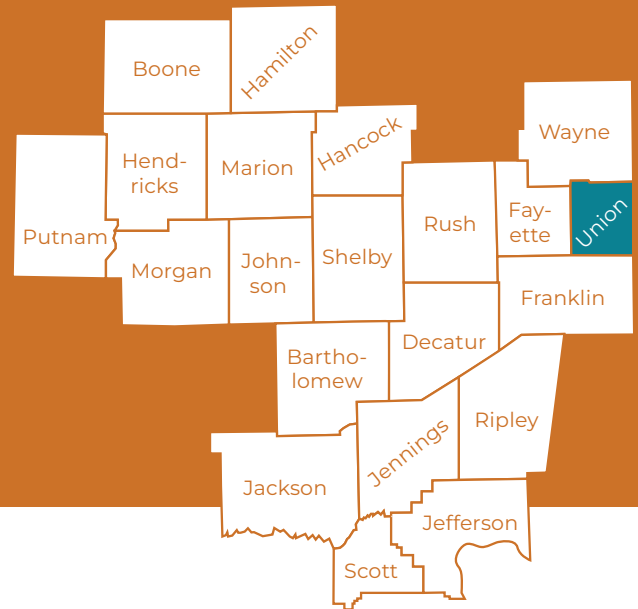


UNION COUNTY 2026 OVERVIEW
